



STORM SUMMARY 1-12-24 thru 1-14-24

Winter storm warning covered much of the area from 3 am on the 12th to noon on the 13th. The bulk of the accumulation occurred in a short period between 4 am and 8 am on the 12th, amounts ranged anywhere from 3.5” to 8.5”. Another band of light snow moved into the area 10-11 pm and continued to mid am on the 13th. The final piece of the storm spread in to the area around 5 pm on the 13th and lasted through midnight. Gusty winds produced blowing and drifting snow along with falling temperatures. Suburbs lowered to subzero by midnight and fall to -10 by dawn on the 14th. Crews began services early am on the 12th and worked through the 14th.

O’Hare officially had 7.1” snow, Romeoville 6.1” snow, MDW 5.8” snow, and Rockford 7.8” snow.
