## ACTION ALERT

A band of snow will be dropping in from southern Wisconsin tonight. It will slowly rotate through the area starting 1 AM-3 AM. The occurrence of this snow is a bit "steadier" light to moderate, but should be around a coating - 1.0", some intense squall pockets could produce up to 1.5". Temperatures will be dropping overnight which will help the accumulation. This period of snow exits toward 8-11 AM on Saturday, though as is the nature of the pattern we are in, snow showers can still linger into the afternoon.

We will have managers out monitoring all regions and will dispatch additional crews to service all zero tolerance properties if hardscape surfaces begin to cover over. Plowing services will only trigger if we surpass 1".

Looking at another clipper system that we may get up to another inch or so very late on Saturday night and Sunday.
