ACTION ALERT

Temperatures drop back below freezing tonight, and some patchy freezing drizzle or additional flurries are possible which can cause some icy spots. Then, more light snow showers likely develop early Sunday morning. These can produce another coating - 1" of snow with locally higher amounts possible if any more moderate / steady snow showers develop (currently higher amounts would be favored near / south of I-88). By late Sunday and into the evening, snow showers will turn more isolated again with a continued risk for flurries into Monday AM.

We will have managers out monitoring all regions on Sunday and will dispatch crews to service all zero tolerance properties as soon as the existing residual we have down is no longer able to combat the oncoming activity.
