



STORM SUMMARY 1-22-24 & 1-23-24

Freezing drizzle mixed with flakes and sleet initially began between 4-6 am on the 22nd. Additional freezing drizzle redeveloped between 6-8 pm on the 22nd and continued to the morning of the 23rd. A winter advisory from 5-9 am on the 23rd was issued. Surfaces were left extremely icy which required multiple applications of salt throughout this event. The freezing rain turned to drizzle and light rain from south to north 9-11 am on the 23rd, causing all activity to freeze on contact as temperatures were in the mid-20s and sub-surface temperatures were in the low 20s. Due to the sub surface temps the cold ground allowed the water to freeze from the group up resulting in a thick coating of ice by dawn on the 23rd. Precipitation ended by late afternoon on the 23rd, some additional areas received drizzle and rain causing surfaces to become slick during early hours on the 24th causing additional salting applications to be completed where needed.
