





## STORM SUMMARY 1-22-24 & 1-23-24

Freezing drizzle mixed with flakes and sleet initially began between 4-6 am on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Additional freezing drizzle redeveloped between 6-8 pm on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and continued to the morning of the 23<sup>rd</sup>. A winter advisory from 5-9 am on the 23<sup>rd</sup> was issued. Surfaces were left extremely icy which required multiple applications of salt throughout this event. The freezing rain turned to drizzle and light rain from south to north 9-11 am on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, causing all activity to freeze on contact as temperatures were in the mid-20s and sub-surface temperatures were in the low 20s. Due to the sub surface temps the cold ground allowed the water to freeze from the group up resulting in a thick coating of ice by dawn on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. Precipitation ended by late afternoon on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, some additional areas received drizzle and rain causing surfaces to become slick during early hours on the 24<sup>th</sup> causing additional salting applications to be completed where needed.
