



STORM SUMMARY 1-28 & 29-23

A winter advisory issued I88 north 9 am to 3 am. The advisory turned into a winter storm warning for Rockford to Lake County. This was expanded southward until 6 am on the 29th. Snow spread into Rockford around 8 am on the 28th before moving into parts of Chicago by 10-11 am. Snow was reluctant to occur much south central and southeast DuPage County and central and southern Cook County southward through the evening hours. The areas received much moisture during the event. The daytime received some freezing rain, sleet and some flakes at night which diminished after midnight. The northern tier of counties kept precipitation in the form of snow for most of the event. Between I88 and I90 snow mixed with sleet and freezing rain before turning to a light snow after midnight. Ending between 3-5 am on the 29th. O'Hare officially had 2.3" snow, .04" freezing rain, Romeoville .10" freezing rain, MDW 1.2" snow, and Rockford 5.1" snow.
