ACTION ALERT

We will see snow start to develop early in the morning toward 4-7 AM, and will likely be snowing in all areas by the start of the morning rush. Snow can be moderate to heavy for a time, enough to possibly cover pavements during the morning as temperatures should at least be cold enough leading into the day. Temperatures will begin to come up toward the middle to upper 30's into the afternoon, so even as snow continues, it should be mostly light which may make for some melting during the daylight hours. Then as we work into the evening, snow can pick back up in coverage, the increased intensity combined with darkness can allow for some re-covering to take place. Remaining snow showers lessen by daybreak Wednesday with a returning risk of snow showers later Wednesday. We will have crews out this evening and during the early Tuesday morning hours deicing all zero tolerance accounts to prepare surfaces for the Tuesday morning rush hour.
