ACTION ALERT

Snow and flurry activity has continued throughout the day with several isolated pockets and squalls of snow this evening that caused immediate pavement and sidewalk coverage with these colds temperatures we are experiencing. These flurries will continue until around midnight tonight. Zero tolerance crews were dispatch early this evening to service any properties that were impacted by these upper level burst of energy.

Additional flurries and snow showers are set to start again late Saturday morning and impact us through the afternoon. These could produce trace coverings to <1" in spots that receive heavier activity. We will also be monitoring this tomorrow during the day and dispatch crews again as conditions warrant.
