



STORM SUMMARY 11-21-24

Scattered showers were present and gradually changed to snow throughout the night of the 20th into the 21st. Local areas received its first snow event of the season as a low pressure system from northern Lake Michigan moved southward through northern Illinois. While majority of the accumulation was on grass and elevated surfaces, the snow intensity was strong enough to overcome the warm surface temperatures and ended up covering pavement during the first 2-3 hours of the event. VIP Red Alert crews were dispatched to perform anti-icing operations.

O'Hare officially had 2.9", Romeoville 2.2", MDW 2.5", and Rockford 0.6".
