





## STORM SUMMARY 11-24-20

A winter weather advisory was issued till 10am for McHenry and Kane County westward. Rain and snow spread into the area between 3:30 and 4:30am. Rain switched to snow after about a half hour and there was a brief period of moderate snow that produced and inch or two of snow on the average except near the lake in Lake County and from ORD to MDW eastward to the lake where amounts ranged from a trace to under an inch with very limited amounts on the pavement. The brief period of snow did leave a covering on the pavement which melted off as the morning hours went on and as air and pavement temperatures continued to rise above freezing. Zero tolerance properties were serviced before the start of Tuesday's work day. Officially O'Hare had .7", Midway .9", Rockford 1.7" and Romeoville 1.5".
