





STORM SUMMARY 12-24 & 25-20

On and off flurries and a couple of snow showers arrived between 12-2am on December 24th. These continued with occasional short lulls before tapering off and diminishing between 8-10pm. Temperatures for this event started in the mid 20's and settling to 10-14 degrees by the end of the event. Blustery winds accompanied this event, with sustained 10-20 mph winds and 25 mph gusts causing patchy blowing and drifting. By the end of the event the rapid temperature dropped cause wet surfaces to freeze over during the early morning hours on December 25th. Crews were dispatch to spot treat and puddle jump to ice patches throughout parking lots.
