



STORM SUMMARY 12-26

A clipper type system tracked from Iowa to central Illinois. The system produced some snow showers, flurries for northern and central Illinois. The coverage of the activity locally was spotty so some areas had zero to trace with the highest being under an inch accumulation. Some residual materials in the lighter areas help with some clearing of the snow. Much of the snow accumulations occurred after 6-7AM. The last of the flurries diminished by 2PM for most areas as the storm moved through. Temperatures were in the mid-teens at the start and topped out in the lower 20s as the severe cold eased up a bit. Some regions required plowing to aid in the removal the snow while other regions required salting/deicing services. O'Hare officially had a Trace of snow, Romeoville 0.2", MDW 0.3" and Rockford 0.4".
