





STORM SUMMARY 10-31-23 & 11-1-23

Light to brief moderate snow intensity lasted about an hour or so that first arrive 7-8AM October 31st with temperatures between 29-32 degrees. Not far behind this, especially by later morning and midday, numerous snow showers developed along with occasionally heavier squalls which lasted through the afternoon as temperatures peaked between 33-36 degrees. Between 5-6PM, areas of moderate to heavy snow became widespread briefly before all activity exited 7-9PM. Activity largely favored colder surfaces, though variable pavement coverage occurred within heavier squalls, particularly late afternoon to evening. Additionally, wind gusts were able to reach 35-40 mph, mainly in squalls, which allowed snow to blow around considerably as well. Zero tolerance crews were out servicing properties during the early morning hours on 10-31 and once again on 11-1-23.
