



STORM SUMMARY 11-27-23

Light snow spread into the area between 4-6AM. Snow amounts were mainly in the 1-3 inch range across the area with the bulk of the accumulation on elevated surfaces such as grass, sidewalks, bridge decks and parking garages.

Pretreated surfaces were able to keep amounts low on paved surfaces while untreated surfaces did receive some covering into mid-morning. After 9-10AM, most treated surfaces remained wet during the duration of the remainder of the event. Snow diminished between 3-5PM to some flurries which lingered in spots till early Monday morning on 11-28. Temperatures stayed around 31-33 degrees during the event while pavement temperatures warmed into the mid 30's by late morning. Officially O'Hare Airport had 1.8 inches which brought the season total to date to 2.7". Rockford had 1.5 inches, Romeoville 1.9" and Midway 0.8 inches.
