



STORM SUMMARY 2-11 & 12-21

The latest in a series of quick moving systems produce more snowfall for the area. The snow actually came in 2 periods although they somewhat overlapped in the lake effect areas. Lake effect flurries and snow showers developed late morning over central Cook County and over eastern Will County. This activity very slowly shifted northward up the shoreline reaching Lake County by evening and exiting Cook. Meanwhile the main system of light snow and flurries spread into the area from the west between 7-10 pm and was pretty much out of the majority of the area by 1-2 am. There were some additional flurries on friday morning the 12th from Rockford to La Salle County over towards Route 59. Officially O'Hare had 0.5", Rockford 1.1", Romeoville 0.3" and Midway 0.3" snowfall.
