ACTION ALERT

We are looking at a long event weekend of snow activity with the 1st period starting this evening up until midnight where we could receive anywhere from a dusting up to 2". The reason for the wide range is due to the lower levels in the atmosphere being very dry. As the front passes through a lot of precipitation could get wasted in the top down saturation process. During the second period of this alert, we will see the activity transition to freezing drizzle and then drizzle through the predawn hours with some light mixed precipitation at times Saturday afternoon.

More snow is anticipated Saturday night into the midday on Sunday. We will send out a new Action Alert tomorrow as we monitor and analyze the most updated model runs.

VIP Red Alert crews have been dispatched and will be ready for the onset of activity. If accumulation approaches the 1" mark operations will flip over to plowing. If you are in need of any snow related service issues please call our 24 hour snow emergency number at 847-344-1027.
