ACTION ALERT

A clipper system passes to our south this evening with another just to our north early Thursday. We will be looking at a potential spotty snow shower risk from sunset to the predawn hours on Thursday. There is not a lot of moisture in the atmosphere but with temperatures as cold as they are it will not take much to coat or dust over surfaces. We currently have down a good amount of residual from Sunday's application and that material should hold off any risk of coverings.
