ACTION ALERT

Our next snow threat is still on track to develop Sunday afternoon. While there may be a brief, light snow shower ahead of the main snowfall around midday, snow won't become more likely until later in the afternoon. Snow will be steady through the evening, falling moderately at times before lightening and tapering off near midnight. It will be much warmer than it has been with temperatures near or just above freezing during the snow, but given the colder ground temperatures and favorable timing (after sunset), around 2" of snow is still expected. After snow ends, temperatures drop back below freezing for early Monday AM which could cause any wet / slushy areas to turn icy.

Zero tolerance crews will be dispatched at the onset to perform salting/deicing operations. As we surpass the 1" threshold plowing operations will kick in. We will begin measuring properties around 9pm to see if thresholds are met for all 2" and over multifamily properties. If these are triggered those operations will most likely kick in around midnight.
