ACTION ALERT

We are currently monitoring a quick moving disturbance entering into our region from the west. There is a lot of dry air for this system to overcome in the lower atmosphere. Returns on radar out in Iowa show snow, but currently is not making it to the ground. With all that said, the threat for a dusting to 1/4" of snow will be possible this evening into early morning. Not a sizable event, but one that can create slippery conditions as we are below freezing at this time. Field managers will be out on jobsites this evening inspecting as this minor event works its way into all regions. Deicing services will be provided if winter conditions dictate.
