



## STORM SUMMARY 2-4 & 5-21

Winter weather advisory was issued from 11am till 12pm on 2-5-21. Light snow spread into the area early afternoon. There was some rain and sleet mixed in with snow especially south suburbs till mid-afternoon. Heaviest precipitation occurred 3-6pm with some light intensity snow till late night and into the early hours on Friday. Temperatures remained around 33-34 degrees until 8pm before temperatures fell into the teens by midnight. Surfaces were extremely icy as temperatures reached the lower teens and saw slush and wet surfaces freeze up. Winds gusted 40-50 mph 6-8pm through midnight which resulted in blowing and drifting snow. Winds remained 15-25 mph with gusts of 30-35 mph throughout the work day on the 5<sup>th</sup> as blowing and drifting continued in wide open areas. After plowing operations were completed multiple applications of deicing product was necessary due to the rapid drop in temperature. Officially the storm produced 2.4 inches of snow at O'Hare, Romeoville 4.4 inches, Rockford airport 1.6 and MDW 2.9 inches.
