





STORM SUMMARY 2-8-21

Some light snow spread up to about I80 during the early morning hours 3-5 am with flurries further north after 6-7 am. Salting was needed in the Joliet to Kankakee areas. Steadier and more prominent light snow spread into the area 1-3 pm and diminished to some flurries 9-11 pm. Snow amounts were quite variable with this event from one location to the next due to the nature of this snowfall. The liquid equivalents would have supported amounts under an inch all areas but there were many locations that had 20-1 and even 30-1 ratios which greatly inflated the snow amounts due to the fluffy nature of the snow. Officially the event produced 4" inches at O'Hare, 3.8" inches MDW, 0.3" inches Rockford and 2.5" inches Romeoville.
