





## STORM SUMMARY 12-2-15

There were some scattered showers prior to midnight on 12-1. Rain then spread into the area between 12-2am before becoming all snow for areas north of I88 3-4am. It took longer for the conversion of rain to snow to occur further south in Will and southern Cook Counties. The forecast had called for the heaviest activity to occur between 4 and 9am and that is exactly what occurred. Pavement temperatures especially south of I90 never went below 32 so the majority of the accumulation mentioned below was on non paved surfaces. There was a little more slushy accumulation further north. Many areas south of I88 only had wet pavement that needed to be treated. By 9am, surface pavement temperatures rose into the upper 30s to mid 40s so no further accumulation occurred even though the last of the flakes did not end till 2pm for Rockford and ended from west to east across Chicago area 3-5pm.
