





## STORM SUMMARY 1-9-16

The day started out with some spotty drizzle along with temperatures between 36 and 40 degrees. Light rain spread into the area between 12:30 and 1:30 pm from southwest to northeast. Rain changed over to snow from the west on a line from Naperville to ORD between 1:30 and 2pm. The precipitation form stayed as rain east of this line until 3-4pm. Air and surface temperatures remained above 32 into the early evening hours which prevented some streets from receiving accumulating snowfall. Surfaces and sidewalks did get slushy snow cover south of I90 and accumulating snow north of that requiring plowing and salting with some areas needing multiple saltings. With the frigid temperatures plowing off the slush was needed in order to clear surfaces as well.
