



STORM SUMMARY 2-1-16

The day started out with some spotty drizzle along with temperatures between 32 and 33 degrees. Light rain continued through the area until rain changed over to snow from the west on a line from Rockford to ORD between 1:30 and 2am. The precipitation form stayed as rain east of this line until 3-4am. Air and surface temperatures remained right at 32 into the early morning hours which allowed some streets to receive light ice in spots. Surfaces and sidewalks did have icy conditions requiring salting. Temps continued to rise after daybreak when all precipitation changed to plain rain.
