





STORM SUMMARY 1-9 & 10-17

A quick period of light snow moved through between 4-7pm. The actual snowfall was very short lived and only lasted a few hours. Amounts were very light but with surface temperatures extremely cold the little snow that fell accumulated on these surfaces which required salting during the precipitation and after to treat them. The second phase came when light rain and drizzle spread into the area around 4-5am. Even though air temperatures were in the Mid 30's the pavement temperatures were still around 31 degrees resulting in the freezing of water on surfaces from the ground up. Another round of salt was needed in some areas for the morning commute mainly north of I88. By 7am pavement temperatures were up to 34 degrees and that alleviated additional icing from occurring.
