



STORM SUMMARY 3-12 & 13-17

A weakening system over Nebraska tracked into western Iowa and moved down towards St. Louis heading into 3-13. This system produced light snow accumulation for the area with exception for some locations near Lake Michigan in northeast Cook and eastern Lake County. A combination of salt and plowing was need to service properties. Pavement temperatures remained just around 32 from the start to nearly dawn on 3-13. By mid am, pavement temperatures were back up in the upper 30s to lower 40s. The main band of snow diminished 10am to noon. Snow showers occurred at times during the afternoon. Lake effect snow began 4-7pm, snow total at ORD for the first snow event was 2.5 inches and Rockford had 2.4.
