





STORM SUMMARY 3-2-17

A weak clipper system produced a band of snow with varying intensities over the area. The activity that produced some accumulation on surfaces moved through between 3-6am. There were still some flakes thereafter but the activity was mostly light flurries and did not produce any additional accumulation. Amounts ranged from a trace to mostly under an inch for the area. This light snow made it difficult to determine where accumulating snow was actually occurring. Pavement temperatures throughout the area rose above 32 between 8-9am which prevented any additional travel issues. O'Hare Airport had a trace, Rockford .1, Romeoville .5.
