





## STORM SUMMARY 12-11-17

A band of flurries and snow showers moved through the area between 5 and 8am. Another band of snow on the backside of a clipper type system pushed down from Wisconsin into Rockford eastward to Lake County between 2-3pm then pushing southward through the rest of the area exiting around 6-7pm; mostly light flurries and snow showers continued throughout the remainder of the evening and into the early morning hours on the 12<sup>th</sup>. There were some heavy returns over northern McHenry & Lake Counties which resulted in the heaviest returns. The duration was shorter and the intensity weaker by the time the area reached the I88 corridor and points southward. Some plowing and salting was needed north while it was mostly a salting operating south. Officially ORD had 1.4inches, RFD 1.1 and Romeoville .4.
