



STORM SUMMARY 1-1-18

After the accumulating snow that officially ending on the morning of Saturday December 30th, crews finished their final deicing treatments and temperatures began to drop further. As the potential for the accumulating lake effect snow that was forecasted for Sunday evening began to diminish the wind chills and sever blowing and drifting advisory increased. From 9pm Sunday the 31st until 12pm Tuesday the 2nd a "Wind Chill Advisory" was issued. Due to Monday being a holiday we let Sunday and Mondays high winds blow around the light and fluffy snow and waited until the overnight hours on the 1st into the 2nd to send crews out to revisit every property before the start of the work week on Tuesday the 2nd. Due to the 2 days of sustained -25 mph winds several properties needed to be partial plowed, corners tucked, piles pushed back, sidewalks shoveled and properties deiced.
