





STORM SUMMARY 1-14 & 15 & 16-18

A winter weather advisory went into effect 6pm on 1-14 till noon 1-15. Light snow began 3-5pm. The snow was constant till the morning of 1-16. This was a long duration light snow intensity event requiring multiple salt and plows as the event went through several commutes. The activity on the 16th turned into more of a lake effect event. Average snow totals over the 3 days was 4-6.5 inches. The snow was fluffier in some areas rather than others which is why the amounts were not uniform. Snowfall at ORD was .8 on the 14th, 2.3 on the 15th and .6 on the 16th for a total of 3.7". RFD was 1.5" on the 14th, 3.4 on the 15th and .1 on the 16th for a total of 5.1". Romeoville was 1.3 on the 14th, 3.2 on the 15th and .1 on the 16th for a total of 4.6".
