



STORM SUMMARY 1-23-18

An area of rain spread into the area by 1-3am. Rain changed to snow from north to south between 3-5am. Heaviest snowfall occurred over McHenry and Lake Counties where snowfall averaged between 1-4 inches while amounts were much less south. Much of the snow south of I90 was mainly on the grass. Salting and plowing was needed in the heavy snowfall areas while salting was needed everywhere south. The activity diminished to flurries by 8am.
