





STORM SUMMARY 12-29-17

Another fast moving system produced another snow event for the area. Snow began in Rockford 10am and then spread into the Chicago area during the noon hour. Snowfall diminished to flurries and patches of non accumulation snow by 7-8pm and this lighter activity ended 2-4am on the 30th. Once again snowfall amounts were light for much of Rockford to Chicago. Further south, there were more impressive amounts with totals 3-5 inches. Salting and plowing was required and cold temperatures again made it a challenge. ORD had .8 which pushed the month total to 5.3 and the season total to 5.4. Rockford had 1.3" and 4.9 for season thus far, Romeoville 1.7 and 5.4 for season to date.
