



STORM SUMMARY 2-17-18

A fast moving area of snow produced another round of measurable snowfall for the area resulting in plowing and salting for the surrounding areas. It was a heavy wet snow for a change. Initially pavement temperatures were in the mid to upper 30's at the onset of the snowfall but these readings quickly fell to around 32 as the heavier snow moved in. Snow began 2-3 pm and the snow exited from west to east between 5-7 pm. On the average, only about .10 of moisture fell but the liquid to snow ratios ran about 15 or 20 to 1 which inflated the snow amounts. O'Hare had 2" which pushed the season to date amounts to 30.1", Rockford had 1.3" with a season total of 28.3" and Romeoville had 1.6" and a season total to date of 31.6".
