



STORM SUMMARY 2-3 & 4-18

The system came through in 2 phases as there was a good 4-6 hours between the 2 phases. There were some scattered flurries/snow showers with some warm air advection that back into the area between 7 and 10pm. Amounts ranged from a trace to under an inch. ORD had .8, Rockford .7 and Romeoville .3. The activity area wide left surfaces wet so salting was needed with this first wave due to the expected drop in temperatures early on the 4th. Additional light snow pushed down from Wisconsin 4-6am with the passage of an Arctic cold front. Temperatures dropped from 32-34 to the mid to upper teens in a span of 2 hours following the front. The snow area became more impressive on radar once the cold air was settled in and the snow lasted till 2-4pm. Salting and plowing was required with this activity.
