STORM ALERT

Snow spreads into Rockford 5-7pm and Chicago areas 7-9pm. Heaviest snowfall overnight and Friday am. Models hint that there maybe some banding of the snow intensities in very narrow areas which will be hard to pinpoint. In these areas overnight, snow rates maybe an inch an hour. Otherwise, rates will be around ¼ to ½ inch per hour. Snow will try to shrivel up late afternoon/evening Friday and then more possible light snow towards dawn Saturday and Sunday.

For all 2" and over Multifamily complexes we will start clearing driveways during the overnight hours as we hit and surpass the 2" threshold and look to complete one pass by late AM and then return to complete a final pass most likely Friday evening into Saturday morning. Sidewalks are always a secondary priority to roadways, cul-de-sacs and driveways and are to be completed once at the end of the overall event, however we will have sidewalk labor onsite to help shovel away from garage doors while machines or trucks are working.
