



STORM SUMMARY 3-5-18

We got into an active weather pattern during the March 5th through March 7 period as first a surface feature moved through during the late afternoon / evening hours and diminished from south to north between 11pm on 3-5 and 1am on 3-6. The precipitation initially began in many areas as rain with sleet mixed in. This transitioned into snow after a couple of hours and the snow part is what diminished around midnight. The combination of air and ground temperatures above 32 limited accumulations to grassy surfaces in some areas. The heaviest snowfall occurred from Rockford to northern Lake County where there were some 1-3 inch amounts which required plowing and salting.
