

## STORM SUMMARY 12-2 & 3-18

Precipitation was ongoing from Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> all the way into Sunday pm the 2<sup>nd</sup>. During this period we received an impressive 1.25" of rain. The very end of this system finished with light snow/drizzle but mostly snow flakes. The overnight temperature especially north of I90 got down to 32 degrees and there was wind activity but not enough to dry out surfaces. Very light snow flurries started up again around 3am and continue into the 2pm afternoon on the 3<sup>rd</sup>. Most of this coated turf and planting beds during the day as the pavement temps began to rise after the 9am hour. We dispatched zero tolerance salt trucks and sidewalks crews at midnight to treat all surfaces for the Monday morning start of the work week.
