ACTION ALERT

We have had a very strong batch of flurries come through the area. Activity seems to run from Mendota to Hardwood Heights Northward to near Waukegan to Cary to Rochelle and down to Mendota. The main area may produce a covering to a quarter of an inch. The current activity should diminish around 9-10pm. We have currently dispatch crews for all open locations; all others crews will be dispatched after 12am to service all hardscape surfaces during the overnight hours when we can be the most effective and vehicles are not present.
