STORM SUMMARY 3-17-18

A wintery mix of light rain/light freezing rain, sleet and some snow entered the Rockford, Aurora, Naperville and Joliet area between 12-1am on the 17th. Pavement temperatures initially were running a little above freezing but began to drop during the 3-5 am timeframe which caused surfaces to ice up. The overall moisture finally exited the area around 8am. The band of moisture actually stalled and never moved further North than a line from Rockford to Elgin to Elk Grove. Areas North of the line did not require service but areas South needed salting, some only on the sidewalks and others both parking lots and sidewalks.
