

STORM SUMMARY 4-9-18

A clipper like system passed through the area starting around 11pm on the 8th and flurried out until 12pm on the 9th. Temperatures dropped below freezing by the 8pm hour and hit a low of 21 degrees by 7am. Ground temperatures fell to the freezing level by late morning after staying above for most of the early morning hours. Initial accumulation was only on mulch/planting beds and grass areas but as we received heavier bands of snow and the temperatures dropped some sidewalks and parking areas did accumulate. Most accumulations happened only on North face areas where the ground temperature was much cooler. Sidewalk and parking lot deicing services were need in the effected areas.
