





STORM SUMMARY 1-1-19

Very heavy rainfall continued throughout the day on 12-31. There was a short break in precipitation during the afternoon before the heavy moisture moved through again from the southwest. The rain turned over to snow around 7pm even thou the air temperature held above freezing till around midnight. The precipitation became mostly scattered and lighter around 10pm but continued as light snow, flurries, drizzle and some freezing rain off and on into the afternoon on 1-1-19. Temperatures continued a slow overnight decline and reach lows in the upper 20's by daybreak Tuesday morning. All zero tolerance crews were dispatch at 2am to service properties and make sure conditions were safe for the start of the first day of 2019!
