ACTION ALERT

Currently the models still differ a little. The US forecast models try to keep the snow south of the IL/WI border and keep lowering their amounts for the areas north of I80 while the Euro models push snow into southern WI and ups their amounts for the area. That model has above 5 inches as far north as ORD. Most of this system is focused over Middle and southern Illinois. If the storm track moves 20 miles north or south the inch total can vary dramatically. We will have trucks and crews out deicing on the onset of the storm to keep conditions safe for zero tolerance properties as the higher intensities will not begin until late morning. We will send an additional update as the snow begins to have a better grasp on snow intensities and 2" threshold start times where necessary.

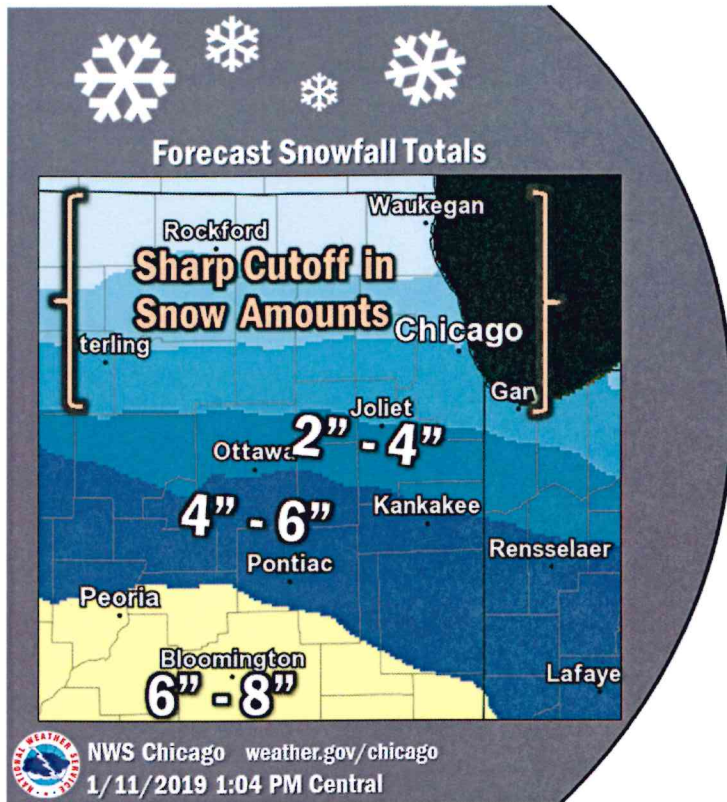
