



STORM SUMMARY 1-12 & 13-19

Light snow spread over the area from south to north between 7-10am on 1-12. Parts of McHenry and Lake County didn't see the snow till 10-11 am. Once the snow began it continued till 3-5 am on 1-13. This was a long duration event.

There intensities were not very uniform at all over the area which is why the amounts did vary from one location to another. Salt was able to keep the snow in check on parking areas for a while in the morning/early afternoon then plowing became necessary. Average snow amounts were 2-4 inches across the area. Amounts increased over Southern LaSalle, Livingston and Iroquois Counties. Officially ORD had 2.5 inches with a season total of 16.8 inches or 3.2 above normal. Rockford had 4.0 inches with a season total of 20.6 or 3.4 above normal.
