# **ACTION ALERT**

It's still possible that the totals may end up rising up North depending upon where the cutoff will end. The snow is fairly light for much of the morning hours north of I80 and heavier south. Snow will pickup in intensity for all areas 1-3pm through about 9-10pm tonight and then it will lighten up again until the early Sunday morning hours. All zero tolerance properties are currently being serviced and we will switch to plowing operations as intensities increase.

For all 2" and over Multifamily complexes if contract thresholds are achieved we will start clearing driveways during the evening hours as the snow begins to slow down (most likely after the 10pm hour, TBD). Sidewalks are always a secondary priority to roadways, cul-de-sacs and driveways and are to be completed once at the end of the overall event.
