ACTION ALERT

We have a very similar situation to last night where the radar is showing very light returns over the area. The activity still appears to be too fine for the automated observation systems at the airports to pickup on however it is very noticeable when walking around outside. Our snow Field Managers have been performing site visits over the last three hours to monitor conditions. We were hoping the residual from last nights application would hold off this precipitation and for the most part we will be fine in the parking areas and sidewalks but the drivelanes and high traffic areas that saw vehicular traffic today are currently wet and have no remaining product left. Temperatures are set to drop to a low of 25 degrees tonight with the fine freezing mist set to exit the area between 2-4am. We will be dispatching salt trucks only to service zero tolerance properties and focus on drive lanes, docks, entries and exits. Drivers will also perform a visual inspection and spot treat parking areas in need of deicing.
