The US forecast models downplay the snow risk late tonight and into Thursday while the Euro model brings some light snow into the area and even up into Wisconsin. The best chance for this is after 8am. Our Snow Field Managers will be out overnight monitoring their regions. We have a good amount of residual down on the parking lots and sidewalk surfaces and anticipate this product will hold off any light flurries. All Zero Tolerance crews are "On Alert" and ready to work for tomorrow morning if conditions warrant.
