





## STORM SUMMARY 1-18 & 19 & 20-19

Storm system passing a good distance south of the local area produced a light fluffy snow for the area which resulted in blowing and drifting snow into the early morning hours of 1-20. Light snow began 1-3pm on 1-18 from Rockford over towards Lake County. Snow then slowly spread over DeKalb, Kane and northern Cook County between 8:30 and 10pm on 1-18. The main band of snow did not spread into much of Will and Southeast Cook Counties until 1-3am on 1-19. The slower arrival time resulted in lower snow totals for much of this area. This main band of snow ended from northwest to southeast across the areas between 9am and noon on 1-19. Some lake effect flurries and snow showers then occurred during the evening hours of 1-19 to early morning on 1-20. The lake effect activity did not produce much in the way of accumulation for most of Lake and Cook Counties.
