## ACTION ALERT

Another clipper system will take aim at our area today into early tonight. This system will bring at least as much snow as yesterday and perhaps even more. Zero tolerance crews and plowing operations if necessary will be "On Alert" and we will dispatch as conditions warrant.

*There is the potential for a large accumulating snow event starting Sunday night and running all day Monday and finishing early Tuesday morning. Currently most snow piles have really grown from the last few events. If Monday's event produces heavy snow totals there is a good chance that many places will run out of areas to stack snow. Please begin to think about additional areas or parking spots that can be allocated for excess snow. If these options are limited; snow relocation or removal will have to be scheduled in between events to open up adequate room. Please contact your account manager to discuss further.*
