





STORM SUMMARY 12-28-18

Rain diminished by 3-4am on 12-28. This was followed by some patchy drizzle and flurries mid-morning through the afternoon. Some flurries with some bursts of heavier snow after 9-10pm till 3-4am on 12-29 was received. Snow amounts ranged from a trace to around an inch. There was more snow on the grass than on the streets but surfaces were wet which turned to ice around dawn on 12-29 as temperatures fell to 24-27 degrees. All zero tolerance accounts received a full deicing for their parking lots and sidewalk surfaces.
