





STORM SUMMARY 1-20 & 21-19

Lake effect activity occurred over the northwest for much of the day on 1-20. This activity produced heavy snowfall for Lake County Indiana. Meanwhile this lake effect activity then moved up the Illinois shoreline after 7-9pm and into the early morning hours on 1-21. Some flurries reached out to Elgin, Naperville and Aurora. Officially ORD received .1 snow while MDW received .2 and Romeoville none.
